Dear Friends of Sudanese,

Partners in Compassionate Care (PCC) is thrilled to report that in 8 more months we are planning to complete Phase 1 of the humanly impossible task of constructing a hospital in Werkok, Sudan. We were facing **5 Giants of:** 1. Building a hospital in a country with no infrastructure. 2. Funding the construction, 3. Communication 4. Logistics 5. Transporting of materials from Nairobi and USA. Because we serve a God **who loves to do the impossible**, what was a grassy field in April of 2006, now contains:

- ❖ A nearly finished 30'x100' hospital building with an operating room, labor and delivery room, central supply, 4 examination rooms, and a 16 bed ward!!
- ❖ A 40' portable operating/recovery room we used for surgery during the construction phase!!
- ❖ A combination eye/dental clinic that is fully equipped for doing eye surgeries and dentistry!!
- ❖ A new kitchen and a separate dining hall with a veranda for longing and eating our meals!!
- ❖ 2 residences for the 2 Sudanese doctors God has blessed us with!!
- ❖ 5 residences for staff and volunteer housing!!
- ❖ A new building that now contains our 15 KvA generator to provide power for the compound!!
- ❖ A storage facility for tools, supplies, and a covered area for the Caterpillar/front end loader!!
- ❖ New latrines and shower facility and a large retaining pond that will be used for drip irrigation!!
- ❖ A new "farm type" fence to keep animals out around the entire hospital compound with 2 gates!

God allowed us to accomplish all of this through your generous giving and the assistance of Dave & Joy Mueller, their 3 sons, and 72 volunteers who all came at their own expense these past 2 years!! Praise God. PCC still is facing **5 more Giants!!** These are giants of staffing, training Sudanese, administering, funding the operational cost of the hospital, and community development!!! God will bring down these 5 new giants if we remain mindful of what God has already accomplished because that will increase our faith and give us courage to face these new giants!! We need to keep our focus on God – not the giants. In order to complete Phase 1, we need to have funding for the following important tasks:

- ❖ Provide running water for the hospital and install a septic system.
- ❖ Finish painting, install storage cabinets, and equip a laboratory for the hospital.
- ❖ Construct an x-ray building and purchase an x-ray machine for the hospital.
- ❖ Build a guard house and build more staff housing for the compound.
- ❖ Install the satellite communication system that God has marvelously provided.
- ❖ Raise \$25,000 to transport the remaining materials and equipment in our warehouse in Grand Rapids, Mi. so that we can complete these tasks and fully equip the hospital.

We are trusting God that you will faithfully join with us in these remaining tasks by giving sacrificially to PCC so that we will have the \$25,000 to ship the container by **October 31** so that it will arrive in Sudan in early January. To complete the other tasks listed above, we will need an additional \$_____. We praise God for all He has provided and done for PCC and we have faith to believe that He will provide funds for these remaining needs. Christ said in Matt. 25:40 "**whatever you have done unto the least of these my brothers and sisters you have done unto me**" Will you join with us by praying for PCC and then giving sacrificially so that these above needs can be met? Thank you.
