I am sending this email from Nairobi as I await the Team from Georgia that I am leading into Sudan. The Pastor of Crosspoint Church and 7 of his members are going into Sudan with me next Saturday. They travel to Nairobi next Monday and they need your prayers as do I. What Martin Luther King said is very true.

We are making progress on this humanly impossible task simply because God is doing this. We are still in need of about \$150,000, in order to complete the first phase of the site which includes a small hospital with an operating room, delivery room, labor room, and 4 examination rooms. We just had a young couple move to the hospital compound in Sudan yesterday. They have 3 boys ages 10, 12, & 15 and are from Grand Rapids. Dave and Joy Mueller have given up their opportunity of living in America with all of the conveniences that we all enjoy simply because God has called them and they are being obedient followers of Christ. Dave is a builder and will be the chief of construction on the hospital compound. We are so blessed to have a man with his 15 years of experience from deep in the jungles of Papua New Guinea now working with us in Sudan. His wife Joy has considerable experience with tropical medicine.

The needs here are so great and the workers are so few for such a huge task. Not all can go but everybody can pray and many can give. Will you prayerfully consider what you could do to help. We have 3 other teams coming to Sudan and we all will need your prayers. If God should so lead you to give, we can provide you with a tax deductible receipt.
